#### **Exchange Policy**

Before you deposit a week, you must pay that year's dues in full. When you deposit your week, you are committing your exchange company to an inbound. Your dues are carefully structured to meet the association's expense of occupancy with nothing left over except a small amount for periodic expenses like fixtures and furnishings. So, if you deposit your week make sure to pre-pay the year's dues. If you are depositing the year you are in, you must complete payments for that year.

#### **How the Payment Schedule Works**

You are billed 3 times per year, in 1/3 increments, in October, February and June. October is the first payment of the year, February is the second and June is the final billing for the year. Starting on October 1, 2014 your bill will go from \$183 to an even \$200, making the 2015 dues \$600 annually. You get a lot of value for that money.
