We hope you are all staying safe and healthy. In our June newsletter last year, we discussed the new procedures that had to be enacted during the COVID-19 pandemic. It's a year later and our local government still has many restrictions in place, though they are starting to loosen as more people in the U.S. become vaccinated. In general, our restrictions in Colorado and Grand County have been more restrictive than many other places in the US. Since we are a tourist destination, our local government has enacted COVID policies to try to keep cases down as visitors come in from other states where restrictions are fewer. Going forward, it's likely we will be able to ease some restrictions at the property. Unfortunately, at this time we are not sure when that will take place. For now, due to county restrictions, the clubhouse (including the laundry area) remains closed to owners and guests and we are required to allow 24 hours between stays to keep our housekeepers and arriving guests safe. That means owners and guests with stays through September should plan to stay only 6 nights and depart on Thursday instead of Friday.

If restrictions in our area ease, we will notify guests with reservations through September as that occurs. Even though the CDC loosened mask restrictions recently, most businesses in our area, including grocery stores, restaurants and retail stores are still requiring masks inside. At Indian Peaks, our highest priority is continuing to keep owners, guests and employees safe.
